Ahmed, Johanna Burnheart's solo output explores more rarefied territory. A refinement of the bespoke style debuted on 2020's Burnheart, Jonny Wickham and Twm Dylan's hooky bass lines combine with Ben Brown's tethered drums and Jonny Mansfield's probing vibraphone to create deeply textured motorik grooves on instrumental standouts Cylla Burna and Fossa Offekonis. While Al MacSween and David Swan ladle in electronica, Burnheart consciously underplays her role, punctuating pulsing bedrocks with stylistic nods to Zbigniew Seifert and a trumpeter's precision. Burnheart's voice is a thing of detached wonder too, whether mirroring her ghostly, echo-treated violin on Ems or traversing left-field chamber pop on Something Cool. A quiet triumph.
